Each evening before and after the performances, we invite you to view a display called Silent Witnesses. The Silent Witness Project is a traveling memorial exhibit that is part of a national initiative to remember those murdered in acts of domestic violence. The exhibit consists of life-size wooden figures, each representing a woman who once lived, worked, had neighbors, friends and family before her death. Each silhouette represents a real person murdered by an intimate partner. It is a visual and compelling way to touch people on a personal level. It uses art as a tool to sensitize people to domestic violence - an issue that affects everyone.

Don't forget to pick up a purple ribbon at this event or at locations throughout our community and wear it during October as a statement of support for the work we do in our communities, and to show that there is no place in our communities for domestic violence. The second performance will be held on Saturday evening, October 15th, beginning at 7:30. Tickets for the Saturday night performance will be \$25 each.
