By registering /purchasing a ticket(s) you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

***** Please call ahead or email haven.events@havenshelter.org if you are a Scentsy/Paparazzi /etc. vendor. The Haven is not responsible for duplicate vendors and will not issue refunds if you don't reach out to us before registering. *****

The Haven will not be hosting food trucks at this event.

1. Setup/ Breakdown: All Vendors and ompetitor must be set up and ready to sell by 12:00 pm the day of the event. Vendors and ompetitors may begin setting up at 10:00 am the day of the event. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE MOVED FROM THE EVENT SPACE BY 11:30am. Break down can start no sooner than 4:00 pm on Saturday and must be completed by 5:30 pm. No Vendor or competitor is to close before the official closing time. Sellers are responsible for their selling spaces. *Before leaving, be sure your area is clean and trash free.
2. Staffing: Vendor and ompetitor tables/ booths must be manned at all times and intact until the show closes at 4 p.m. The Haven Shelter & Services is not responsible for merchandise or display materials.
3. Vendor Items: If participating as a vendor The Haven Shelter & Services reserves the right to have items removed that are considered inappropriate.
4. Vendor Responsibility: Vendor and ompetitor will be fully responsible for any loss or damage to his or her property by theft, fire or casualty. The Haven Shelter & Services expressly disclaims any responsibility for the same. Vendors and ompetitors shall be responsible for any damage which may be incurred to the facilities as a result of or in connection with its operation. Each Vendor and ompetitor is responsible for the conduct of their employees and/or representatives and activities must not detract from the image or welfare of the market.
5. Vendor Spaces: Vendor and ompetitor spaces will be assigned. Placement, flow and competition will be taken into consideration to provide the best experience for fair attendees. If you have special space needs, please include your request with your application and we will make every effort to accommodate you. Spaces are reserved on a first-come first-served basis. Vendors and ompetitors must ensure that none of their display equipment extends beyond the space they have booked; this includes any rails, stands or additional equipment. Vendors must provide their own table and chair. Vendor space may not be sublet or shared without prior approval of an authorized staff of The Haven Shelter & Services.
6. Acceptance: The Haven Shelter & Services reserves the right to decline any application for space if it deems such action to be in the best interest of the organization itself.
7. Payment: The full payment is a non-refundable registration fee for the selected space and is due with the submission of this agreement. This fee will be used to cover advertising and other incidental costs associated with the production of this event.
8. Electricity: Electricity will be available for COMPETITORS ONLY.
Extension cords are not included in the registration and must be provided by the ompetitor.

9. Cancellation of space: Registration fees are not refundable. The Haven Shelter & Services is not liable if weather or other conditions prevent the Vendor from attending and fulfilling the contractual obligation as a Vendor or Competitor. No refunds will be made for weather, accident, health or other causes for non-participation.

10. Indemnification: Vendor and Competitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Haven Shelter & Services and the event host from and against any loss, expense, claims, damages, causes of action, injuries, suits or damages, suits to person or property, including attorney's fees, arising out of or related to the operation of the Vendors at events organized by The Haven Shelter & Services.

Souper Chili Cookoff Rules

Cookoff Rules:

Single contestants or teams are welcome. Set up location will be assigned prior to the event. Contestants must provide their own ingredients, equipment, serving utensils and fuel. Any soup, chili, stew, gumbo, etc. qualifies as an entry for the Souper Chili Cookoff. It is suggested that each contestant cooks a minimum of at least 8 gallons (32 quarts) of soup. Competitors are allowed to cook a total of two soups/chilis/etc. All contestants are responsible for the proper temperature for serving. The Haven Shelter & Services, Inc. will provide spoons, cups, and napkins for serving to the general public. The soup must be brought already cooked to the site and must be ready to serve at 12pm.

People's Choice Judging:

Each competitor will be given a number which will be visible to the public. The voters may purchase tasting tickets to either order a sample or cup of soup. 1st place will be given to the competitor with the most tickets. Tasting begins from 12pm to 3pm. After 3pm, the tickets will be counted and a winner announced.

Ingredients:

Please indicate on the competitor application if your recipe contains potential allergens such as nuts, dairy, shellfish, etc. Additionally, please indicate a level of spice (if any) such as mild, medium, or hot.
